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Please consider the following:

1. The blue print should layout a clear path for NYS to become carbon free by 2050. It does not do that .
2. The blue print should be realistic. Thinking fusion reactors will be commercial by 2050 is not realistic .
3. NYSERDA funding strongly influences where industry conducts research. This needs to be taken into account. This blue print needs to be in sync with funding programs.
4. Technologies such as fast reactors, Liquid Metal coolants, gas reactors , have been tested previously and much data is available. A beginning step in this plan should be to study this data and determine if any are feasible by 2050. This will allow more effort to be applied to fewer options which is more efficient.
